### Tyee Is Happening!

Donors, board members, staff, press and friends gathered Thursday, September 24 to celebrate the next important step in the Camp Fire Delivers Capital Campaign for Camp Killoqua – learning who will be doing the construction of Tyee the fourth of the five new structures at camp.

Board President, Cindy Phillips welcomed visitors thanking the over 100 volunteers, passionate board members, dedicated staff and donors for their commitment and passionate support to our community's youth.

Executive Director, Dave Surface announced that the Board of Directors was awarding Allied Construction the contract. They made the lowest bid and are making a \$25,000 in-kind donation to the campaign.

Campaign Co-Chair, Pete Baffaro said "I am thrilled to announce that even though the economical environment has been very challenging this past year, we currently have pledges totaling \$2,501,288!" He added, "The Murdock Foundation 'challenged' us to raise an additional \$161,000 to receive their \$100,000 'Top-Off' grant; so this Tyee building would get built in time for next spring."

He went on to say, "I would like to acknowledge the people that helped us reach that goal and meet the challenge: Hank Robinett & Rich Boyden, PEMCO and Stan McNaughton, The Nysether Families & Foundation, Andy Hall for his architectural services, The Cole Foundation, Employees Community Fund of Boeing Puget Sound, and Chris & Linnea Covington of Structural Design Associates. Each of them had already supported our campaign with a major gift, and each stepped up for a second time to make this happen!"

This new structure also includes a large covered meeting and cookout area and a deck.

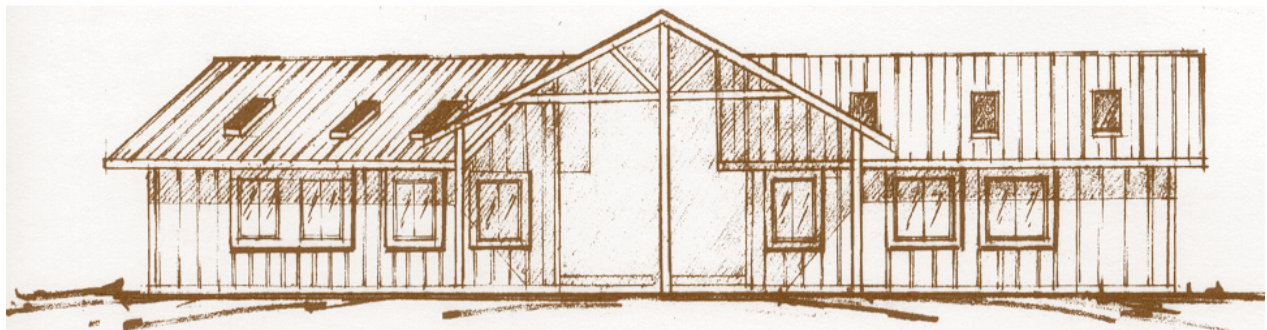
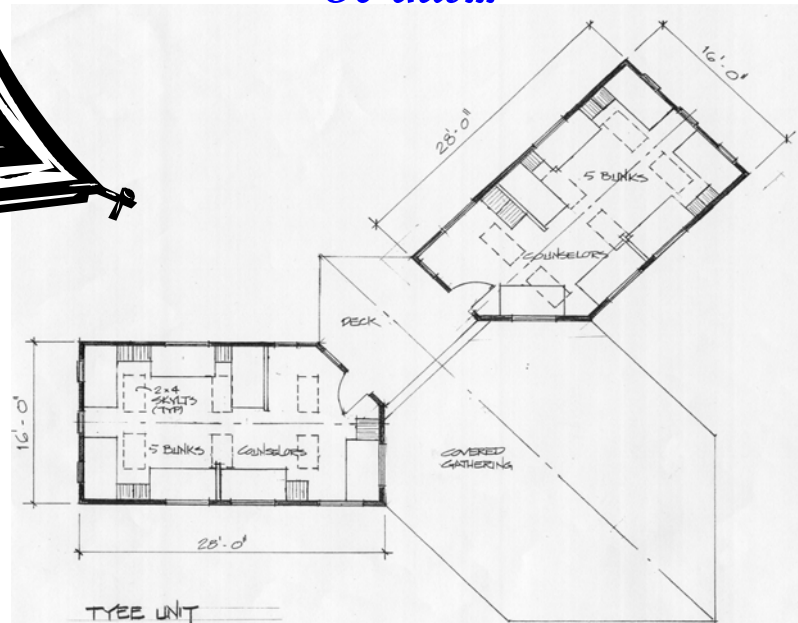

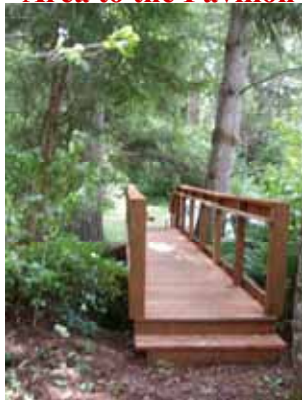
