

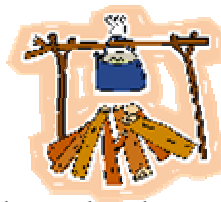
Leader's Outdoor Training Course: Sign-up Today!

The next Outdoor Training course is scheduled for Thursday March 5th and Friday/Saturday March 13-14. The training starts with a short weekday evening session in the Training and Resource Center and will culminate in an overnight at Killoqua. Participants begin on March 5th in a classroom setting from 7pm - 9:00ish, with the overnight beginning at 7pm on March 13 and ending at about noon on March 14.

At the evening session leaders, and other adult club volunteers, will become familiar with how to plan an outdoor experience including meal planning, identifying supplies and materials and all related procedures. During the overnight, participants will learn and/or review outdoor skills (fire building to tents and shelters), learn new and exciting games and become familiar with the resources available at Killoqua.

Leaders who have completed Outdoor Training previously may refresh their skills by either attending both sections or just the overnight. The cost for the training is \$20 and includes breakfast and lodging.
